When: October 31st 8am-5pm and November 1st from 12pm-completion.

Where: Southern California Live Steamers at 2290 Washington Ave, Torrance, CA 90501
next to Wilson Park at 2200 Crenshaw Blvd, Torrance, CA 90501.

What: My project aims to improve the landscaping at Southern California Live Steamers (SCLS) and to prevent erosion around their miniature railroad. I will be building a 50 ft long wall out of railroad ties. It will be 2 railroad ties high (staggered) and the first layer will be put slightly underground. I will drill holes in the railroad ties and put rebar in it to hold it all together. I will also be clearing some vegetation in an area approximately 550 square feet and laying ground cloth and mulch to prevent weeds from growing.

Bring: A mask, troop t-shirt, work gloves, sun protection, and water. If you have one, please bring a shovel, drill, and wheelbarrow.
