

T413 Summer Camp WHAT TO BRING

MANDATORY ITEMS

Mask that covers mouth and nose
Completed forms (turned in **at summer camp meeting or before**)
Merit Badge Prerequisites (completed work)
Notebook, Paper, Pens
Scout Handbook
Sack Lunch (first day)
Flashlight

CLOTHING – mark with name

Scout Uniform (Class A with pants) with **troop neckerchief and hat**
Pajamas or sleep attire
Sweater or Lightweight Jacket
Rain poncho or jacket
Troop hat (required)
Jeans (one pair)
Troop T-Shirts (minimum 3)
Shorts (min. 2)
Swim Suit and Towel (small)
Tennis Shoes and/or Hiking Shoes
Water Shoes or old Tennis Shoes (no open-toed shoes)
Socks (min. 4 pair)
Underwear (6 pair)

CAMPING GEAR

Sleeping Bag and Pad
Duffel Bag (with name & troop # written on Duct Tape)

TOILET KIT

Toothpaste and Toothbrush
Soap and Shampoo
Medication (if needed)
Emergency Toilet Paper
Personal First Aid Kit with bandaids
Comb
Sunscreen— **IMPORTANT**
Chap-stick

MISCELLANEOUS

Camera (cheap/disposable) - optional
Flashlight Batteries
Compass (Silva type)
Scout Knife (blade no longer than palm; no switchblades)
Water Bottle
Daypack

Sunglasses

Mosquito repellent

Watch

Spending Money—\$40-60 recommended including \$8 for lunch on drive home

Bag for dirty clothes

Fishing Tackle (optional)

If taking Lifesaving, Swimming, or Canoeing MB bring extra clothes for survival in the water: long pants, long-sleeved shirt, socks, shoes.

THINGS TO LEAVE AT HOME

Please do not bring the following items to camp.

Open-toed shoes, Valuables, Illegal Substances, Alcohol, Tobacco

Water Balloons, Water Guns, Firearms, Ammunition, Fish Spears, Bikes

Matches, Fireworks, Footlockers, Comic Books, Television

Radios, Music Players, Framed Backpacks, Pets

Jewelry, Pagers, Laser Pointers

Large Knives, Cell Phones (will not work at camp)

Food (except for first day's lunch) – not needed and will be eaten by animals
